Each application will be vetted - proof of service required for non veteran post applicants.(copy of Service record DD214 or Honorable Discharge document)

The \$50 fee for each paver must be paid at the time of ordering.

The Fair Lawn Honor Walk - Third Phase

The Fair Lawn Veterans Council plans to install additional individually-inscribed pavers at the Honor Roll site in front of the Municipal Building during 2015. The intent is to recognize the US military service of present, former and deceased Fair Lawn residents; the military service of their family members; residents currently on active duty with the US Armed Forces; and Fair Lawn members of the US military reserves and National Guard.

New pavers will be added to the existing site in the area between the flagpole and the Fair Lawn Avenue sidewalk.

Each paver will be 4" X 8", salmon colored with black engraving, similar to those already installed at the Honor Walk site. Engraving will consist of three (3) lines of thirteen characters (13), including spaces and punctuation. Text is of the purchaser's choice such as name, rank, unit/ship, services dates etc.

This is a non-profit project and the actual cost for each engraved paver is \$50.00. The cost of the design, spacers, border pavers, and installation are being paid for by the Fair Lawn Veterans Council from its Monuments Reserve Account.

All applications will be vetted by at least one of Fair Lawn's four US Veteran Posts. Some proof of US military service for non post members is required. i.e.: copy of DD214 Service Record, US military Honorable Discharge, Veterans Post Membership card, or any other military record. Note: All members of the American Legion, Catholic War Veterans, Jewish War Veterans, and Veterans Of Foreign Wars are routinely vetted when they apply for membership.

Application forms are available from all four Fair Lawn US veteran posts, the Public Library, Fair Lawn Senior Citizen Center, and Borough Managers office. All applications and payments must be received no later than August 01, 2015.

FAQ:

- 1.) Can there be more than one paver per individual? **NO.**
- 2.) Can I reserve a place to be near/adjacent to my comrades and family members? **NO.** Pavers will be randomly placed.
- 3.) Can I order pavers for deceased family members? **YES.** Some proof of US military service or veterans post membership must be provided.
- 4.) Are post auxiliary members eligible? **NO,** unless they themselves served in the military.
- 5.) Can my business or organization donate a paver? **NO.**
- 6.) Can I make an anonymous donation? **NO.**
- 7.) Are veterans of foreign military services eligible? **NO.**
