- 4) Quorum Declared
- 5) Pam Coles, Craig Miller, Rich Seibel and Larry Koplik, Fair Lawn residents, were welcomed to the meeting.
- 6) The minutes of the FLHPC meeting on March 14, 2012 were discussed. Maureen moved and Laura seconded a motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed.
- 7) Felice provided a summary of the April 9, 2012 Planning Board meeting concerning the Daly Field development. The next Planning Board meeting on the topic is May 14, 2012.
- 8) Ray provided a summary of the relevant March 19, 2012 Open Space meeting topics. The white house next to the Naugle site is being considered for acquisition by the Borough. The property owner replied to a letter from the Borough that they may be interested in selling at this time. The Council and Borough Manager will follow up accordingly. Open Space Grants would be used for the purchase along with Borough Open Space funds. No dollar details are available at this early date in the process.
- 9) Felice summarized a proposed letter to investigate possible Federal Jurisdiction over certain aspects of the Daly Field development. She will circulate a draft for further discussion before such a letter is sent.

- 10) Felice asked for ideas to respond to a request from Arcadia Books for assistance with a project on notable Fair Lawn people in Fair Lawn's history. This will be discussed with Jane Diepeveen at a future meeting.
- 11) Felice reminded everyone about the Fair Lawn Green Fair to be held on May 22, 2012 and asked for volunteers to work at the FLHPC table.
- 12) Ray advised that Eric Holtermann of HMR Architects is tentatively scheduled to inspect the Naugle House interior on April 17, 2012.
- 13) The October program night was discussed. Ideas include HMR Architects for a Naugle House forum and a speaker to be determined for the topic of preservation easements.
- 14) Felice advised there is no new information on the new Fair Lawn Mater Plan.
- 15) An updated membership roster was circulated to members. Everyone is asked to note their term expiration dates and re-apply before the respective year ends.
- 16) The Fair Lawn Town Crier was discussed. The consensus was to get him involved in FLHPC events, specifically the October Program night.
- 17) Public comments were offered by Rich Seibel who suggested a Flagpole be placed at the Naugle site with a Betsey Ross or other historic flag to be flown there. Pam Coles questioned the need for rezoning at the Naugle site. Pam also suggested the Historic Preservation ordinance be reintroduced at a Council meeting. Larry Koplik indicated the Eagle Ceremony for Kevin Northrop is set for May 21, 2012 and requested the FLHPC recognize Kevin's work on restoring a Radburn Gazebo.

Maureen moved and Rich seconded a motion to adjourn. The motion passed.
