IMMINENT HAZARD at DR. KATZ OFFICE, 15-01 Broadway- suite #38

Premises were found to be overcrowded with 37 persons – maximum occupancy is 20 persons; plus, persons assembled in corridor to obstruct the means of egress. The premises were ordered vacate immediately and \$2,000 penalty was imposed. This is the 3rd such violation/penalty within 13 months.
