

## SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 31, 2000

Deputy Mayor Adler called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Municipal Clerk Kwasniewski read the statement of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

PRESENT: Deputy Mayor Adler, Councilmembers Amato, Dobrow and Etler.

ABSENT: Mayor Ganz.

ALSO PRESENT: Manager Sacks, Attorney Lustgarten and Municipal Clerk Kwasniewski.

### ORDINANCES: FIRST READING

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and seconded by Councilmember Dobrow, it was unanimously agreed to read the following ordinance by title.

Ordinance No.1823-2000

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF FAIR LAWN, 2000 MORE SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 125, ENTITLED, "LAND DEVELOPMENT", SECTION 10, OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, AND SECTION 41, SIGNS, SUB-SECTIONS B, AND F, and SECTION 48.A(2), OFF STREET PARKING

Upon motion by Councilmember Dobrow and a second by Councilmember Etler, Resolution No. 274-2000 introducing Ordinance No. 1823-2000 was unanimously passed.

### ORDINANCES: SECOND READING

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and seconded by Councilmember Dobrow, it was unanimously agreed to read the following ordinance by title and open the time for public hearing.

Ordinance No.1814-2000

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF FAIR LAWN, 1981, BY AMENDING CHAPTER II, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION", TO BE RETITLED "ADMINISTRATION, DEPARTMENTS AND BUDGET AND FISCAL PROCEDURES", AND TO AMEND THE TEXT TO REFLECT THE CURRENT STATUS, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES OF THE VARIOUS DIVISIONS OF THE BOROUGH GOVERNMENT

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and a second by Councilmember Dobrow, it was unanimously agreed to take Resolution No. 256-2000 from the table.

Attorney Lustgarten explained that at the last meeting the copies of the ordinance available for the public only contained the odd numbered pages. Technically they could have adopted it because it was published correctly, but the Mayor wanted to be sure the public had the opportunity to review the ordinance in its entirety.

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and a second by Councilmember Dobrow, Resolution No. 256-2000 adopting Ordinance No. 1814-2000 was unanimously passed.

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and seconded by Councilmember Dobrow, it was unanimously agreed to read the following ordinance by title and open the time for public hearing.

Ordinance No. 1822-2000

"AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF FAIR LAWN, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY" AS AMENDED

There being no comments by the public, upon motion by Councilmember Amato and a second by Councilmember Dobrow, it was unanimously agreed to close the time for public hearing.

Upon motion by Councilmember Amato and a second by Councilmember Dobrow, Resolution No. 275-2000 adopting Ordinance No. 1822-2000 was unanimously passed.
